Full and rich with soft tannins, the lush layers of fruit and spice are backed by lively acidity. Glass 9 Bottle 27

**Conde de Valdemar (Rioja, Spain) 2006**

Full bodied classic Rioja, smooth & up front, with a light veil of oak sitting on top of black fruit. Glass 9 Bottle 27

**Santa Julia Organica Malbec (Mendoza, Argentina) 2008**

Organically Grown Grapes. Vibrant with aromas of ripe cherries with a hint of spiciness. Glass 9 Bottle 27

**Green Lion Merlot (Napa, California) 2006**

Juicy and delicious merlot with nice structural tannins with aromas of berries & sweet chocolate. Glass 10 Bottle 30

**Joel Gott Zinfandel (Napa, California) 2006**

Currant, plum & sweet oak aromas with berry & spicy flavors with a sweet & juicy finish. Glass 11 Bottle 33

**Casa Barranca Syrah (Ojai, California) 2007**

Organically Grown. Dark, Concentrated and Loaded with Earthy, Spicy Notes. Glass 11 Bottle 33

**Kermit Lynch Cotes Du Rhone Villages (France) 2006**

**Pennywise Petite Sirah (Yountville, California) 2005**

### Pinot Noir

#### **451 - Permutations (Victoria, Australia) 2008**

A rich heady nose with developing aromas of earth, cherry and raspberry, with a smooth silky palate. \$26

#### **443 - Au Bon Climat (Santa Barbara, California) 2007**

Well balanced, nicely textured, brightly fruity wine that seems to go with everything. \$30

#### **453 - Orchid Hill (Paso Robles, California) 2004**

A pleasant fruit bouquet & is very food friendly. The finish is dry & has a touch tannin. Half Bottle \$22 Bottle \$44

#### **442 - Domaine Lucien Boillot & Fils Bourgogne (Burgundy, France) 2005**

Aromas of earth and minerals backed up with rich ripe fruit, balance and a big tannic structure. \$45

#### **438 - Casa Barranca (Santa Rita Hills, California) 2007**

Delicious from the first sip, this wine is loaded with gorgeous fresh sweet cherry, vanilla and plum. \$47

#### **457 - EMERITUS (Russian River, California) 2006**

91 points Wine Spectator: Spice, floral and wild berry aromas. Finishes with a burst of wild berry flavors. \$55

#### **452 - Demetria Jours De Bonheur (Sta. Rita Hills, California) 2005**

Full of fruit, limestone and soft tannins. \$45

#### **447 - Bogle (Sierra Foothills, California) 2006**

Nicely-textured Old Vine Zinfandel; easy on the palate and smooth in the aftertaste. \$25

#### **463 - Paul Dolan (Mendocino County, California) 2005**

100% Organic & Biodynamic Farmed, flavors of black pepper, black cherries, currants, and smoky oak. \$35

#### **449 - Seghesio Old Vine (Alexander Valley, California) 2005**

Loads of peppery, spicy, black cherry, and raspberry fruit. Vibrant acidity, medium to full body. Half Bottle \$26 Bottle \$55

### Cabernet Sauvignon

#### **422 - Santa Julia Organica (Mendoza, Argentina) 2007**

100% Organically grown. Deep ruby color with black cherries, currant and plum flavors. \$27

**415 - Pennywise (Napa Valley, California) 2005**

Ripe black-cherry and cassis flavors with French oak tannins & a silky, elegant finish. \$30

**429 - Plantagenet Great Southern (South Australia) 2003**

Intense Fruit characters of red berry & cassis, with strong earthy and mineral elements. \$45

**432 - Chateau Montelena (Napa Valley, California) 2005**

Savory black currant fruit notes intermixed with some licorice and spice jump from the glass. \$65

**418 - Beringer Private Reserve (Napa Valley, California) 2004**

Their finest Cabernet of the vintage, a wine of uncommon opulence, distinction and grace. \$84

**417 - Stags Leap Wine Cellars Artemis (Napa Valley) 2005**

Flavors of cassis & black cherry fill the mouth as notes of violets and vanilla linger on the finish. Half Bottle \$43 Bottle \$85

**409 - Chateau St Jean Cinq Cepages (Sonoma, California) 2004**

Cab Sauv, Cab Franc, Malbec, Merlot, Petit Verdot are blended to create this rich Bordeaux style wine. \$95

**425 - Rubicon Estate Cask Cabernet (Napa Valley) 2005**

A classic, grand style American Cabernet. It is loaded with ripe red cherry and rum raisin scents. Half Bottle \$55 Bottle \$110

**437 - Chimney Rock Elevage (Stags Leap District Napa, California) 2005**

Layers of blackberry, blueberry, black currant, highlighted with vanilla and dark chocolate. \$120

**Syrah - Shiraz**

**460 - Yalumba Shiraz Viognier, 2005 (Barossa, Australia)**

100% Certified Organic. The palate is supple, chewy & delicious with sweet fruits & loose tannins. \$25

**454 - Ojai Ridge Syrah (Ojai, California ) 2006**

A rich, fruity red, from a small production by a talented winemaker here in Ojai. \$30

**419 - Thorn-Clarke Shotgun Shiraz ( Barossa Valley, Australia) 2006**

Rich and plush, with lots of spicy, creamy oak around a plump core of cherry and black olive. \$36

**450 - Wolf Blass Gold Label Shiraz (Barossa Valley, Australia) 2005**

Soft, rich & elegant, this is a medium bodied wine with aromas of blueberries, blackberries & dark plum. \$45

**435 - Carina Cellars Syrah (Santa Ynez Valley, California) 2005**

Lovely floral, black currant, cherry and earth notes along with tart acidity as well as a medium body. \$50

**Spanish**

**414 - Guelbenzu Vierlas (Ribera del Queiles) 2004**

A mix of Syrah, Merlot, Tempranillo, Cabernet Sauvignon and Grenache. \$26

**416 - Domino de Tares Baltos Tinto Mencia (Bierzo) 2006**

Toasty oak notes mingle with wild berry and cherry flavors in this alluring red, the tannins are firm. \$33

**423 - Onix (Priorat) 2006**

Grenache & Carinena produces a bouquet of dark plums, sweet black cherries & hints of rosemary. \$40

**446 - Muga Reserva (Rioja) 2004**

Deep ruby in color, it is soft and ripe in the mouth with gorgeous flavors of blackberries and cherries. Ranked # 65 in Wine Spectator's 2008 Top 100 Wine's of the Year. 91 Points. \$45

**424 - Campillo Reserva ( Rioja) 1998**

This elegant red shows a dark ruby color, aromas of spice and plum. \$46

**465 - Emilio Moro (Riber de Duero) 2005**

Black cherry & plum flavors show focus and depth in this rich, polished red. Espresso and mineral notes add complexity, and there's a firm core of well-integrated tannins. \$50

**428 - Remelluri (Rioja) 2003**

Shows a core of ripe fruit, but the berry and plum flavors are muted now. A wonderful Spanish wine. \$60

**French**

**458 - Pierre Chermette, Beaujolais (Burgundy) 2006**

Bright fruit and tart acids, although the fruit is understated and more earth focused. \$26

**431 - Domaine Grand Veneur Cotes Du Rhone (Rhône) 2005**

Superb terroir, the wine shows flavors of ripe red berries. Compliments red meats and cheese. \$37

**430 - Chateau Bolaire (Bordeaux) 2005**

Rich in flavor with vibrant aromas of violet, lavender and cedar. Dry and Peppery. Half Bottle \$26 Bottle \$52

**440 - CHÂTEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE "TÉLÉGRAMME"(Rhône) 2006**

Savoury with an undercurrent of cherry, dried herbs and lavender. This is rounded and silk like to begin, with the opening being all ripe cherry. \$65

**Italian**

**448 - Tormaresca Neprica ( Puglia) 2006**

A wonderful wine from Southern Italy, a blend of Negroamaro, Primitivo, and Cabernet Sauvignon. \$20

**433 - Palladio Chianti (Tuscany) 2005**

Perfumes of cherries and fresh red fruits, mingled with spicy peppery notes. \$22

**420 - Cecchi Chianti Arcano (Siena) 2006**

100% Organic, even the label. Notes of vanilla, fruit, and soft mocha. \$30

**434 - Di Majo Norante (Molise) 2004**

100% Aglianico Grapes. Full bodied with fine grained tannins surrounding a soft, velvety finish. \$31

**466 - Allegrini Palazzo del Torre (Veneto) 2004**

This blend of 70% Corvina Veronese, 25% Rondinella and 5% Sangiovese aromas of currant, blackberry and licorice. Full-bodied and rich it is a classic accompaniment to grilled or roasted meats. \$36

**464 - Bruno Giacosa Dolcetto D'Alba (Piedmont) 2007**

90 points. Good dark red. Aromas of black cherry, licorice and spices. Very supple with broad tannins. \$45

**436 - Damilano Barolo (Piedmont) 2003**

Intense aromas of plums, mushroom and cedar follow through to a full-bodied palate. \$70

**439 - Coldi Sole Brunello Di Montalcino (Tuscany) 2003**

Full bodied and assertive, a wonderful wine to accompany filet mignon and cheese. \$90

### **306 - Red Lion (Napa, California) 2007**

Slightly Buttery with distinct minerality and citrus on the nose with rich stone fruits and white melon on the palate. \$30

### **324 - Olivier Savary Chablis (Burgundy, France) 2006**

Very crisp & fresh on the palate, with nice lemon, lime & mineral flavors. Half Bottle \$ 18 Bottle \$36

### **311 - Chateau de La Greffiere, Macon - La Roche Vineuse (Mâconnaise, France) 2006**

Floral, peachy and apple fruit flavors with a hint of chalky minerality dusted with a slight nuttiness. \$40

### **318 - Au Bon Climat (Santa Barbara, California) 2006**

Fragrant, with a pretty core of ripe pear and nectarine, along with a touch of cream and spice. \$40

### **315 - Demetria Gaia Vineyard (Sta. Rita Hills, California) 2005**

Has Meyer Lemon, Crème Brule & Char Flavors with Firm Minerality. Rated a 93 By Wine Enthusiast. \$48

### **316 - Stags Leap Wine Cellars Karia (Napa Valley, California) 2006**

Peach, crisp apple and pear aromas, with floral notes like honeysuckle and rose petal. \$52

### **329 - Beringer Private Reserve (Napa Valley, California) 2006**

Tropical notes, creme brule and butterscotch that come together for a plush finish. Ranked # 47 in Wine Spectator's 2008 Top 100 Wine's of the Year. 92 Points. \$55

### **307 - Chateau Montelena (Napa Valley, California) 2006**

Bright yellow gold, with good color density. It smells great, the palate is very nice, very smooth, with classic flavors of apple and kiwi, and a lovely finish that leaves the palate refreshed. \$62

### **305 - Cakebread Cellars (Napa Valley, California) 2006**

Bright and tangy with a smooth texture. Lovely balanced fruit and a smashing finish. \$72

## Sauvignon Blanc

### **303 - Steelhead (Dry Creek Valley, California) 2006**

100% Organic & Biodynamic, Citrus & grapefruit zest with pleasant mineral character. \$26

### **314 - Joel Gott (Central Coast, California) 2007**

Exhibits aromas & flavors of passion fruit, melon, citrus, & hints of jasmine with a clean and long finish. \$31

### **301 - Groth Sauvignon Blanc (Napa, California) 2007**

A fine balance of mineral and herb flavors. \$33

### **320 - Domaine Des Grandes Perrieres Sancerre (Loire Valley, France) 2006**

Imported by Kermit Lynch. Bright, lively & has that chalky, limestone flavor that Sancerre is known for. \$40

### **312 - Stags Leap Wine Cellars (Napa Valley, California) 2006**

Grassy in color with crisp acidity and honey dew and melon flavors and a clean refreshing finish. \$43

### **309 - Cakebread (Napa Valley, California) 2006**

Loaded with ripe, intense lemon skin, green apple, fig, and grass and vanilla flavors. \$48

## Spanish

### **328 - Marques de Riscal (Rueda) 2006**

From one of the oldest Wineries in Rioja. 85% Verdejo & 15% Viura. Ripe fruit flavors balanced by a pleasing citrus acidity on the finish that cries out for food. \$23

**310 - Naia (Rueda) 2006**

100 % Verdejo Grapes. Light and round on the tongue, the juicy peach, tart grapefruit and herbal flavors. \$27

**300 - Vina Sila Las Brisas (Rueda) 2006**

Rueda is a famous white wine region in North-Central Spain. Beautiful citrus aromatics. 50% Verdejo, 50% blend of Sauvignon Blanc and Viura. \$29

**317 - Licia Albariño (Rias Biexas) 2006**

Showcases green apple fruit characteristics as well as a pleasing minerality and a fresh lemon finish. \$33

**326 - Valle Reale Trebbiano D'Abruzzo (Abruzzo) 2006**

Medium weight with flavors of pear and apple and a soft finish. Perfect for a summer. \$25

**304 - Zenato Pinot Grigio (Veneto) 2006**

Refreshing & soft with a smooth dry finish. Pairs well with the Paella and the Sea bass. \$29

**327 - Allegrini Soave (Veneto) 2006**

The crisp, citrus aroma lingers on the palate and is framed by great acidity and minerality. \$32

**325 - Terredora Dipaolo Greco Di Tufo (Campania, Italy) 2006**

Outstanding elegant & balanced wine with captivating character of minerals, citrus, honey & floral nose. \$35
